<b>Title</b>	Maskulinitas dan Pandemi COVID-19: Studi Kasus Pakistan
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<b>Abstract</b>	This research aims to elaborate on the question of why male patients of COVID-19 dominating globally (data are taken per 24 June 2020). Depart from the hegemonic masculinity concept, the argument proposed in this writing is that traditional gender role which positioned men as breadwinner is one of the vital factors to the high infection among men. Men who are supposed to work outside their house is arguably more vulnerable to the virus. The argument is extracted from both Pakistan experience against COVID-19. According to UN Women, this country is top the list of countries who has the highest disparity among male and female patient, reaching more than 70 percent of male and 30 percent for the female. The statistic goes hand in hand with the notion of traditional gender roles rooted deep within the community.
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
