## Morphological Analysis of Compound Form (Fukugoudoushi) Verb+Ageru in Japanese

Abstract	This study aimsÃ, to investigateÃ, the formation and meaning ofÃ, fukugoudoushiÃ, or compound verb formed from the Verb+ageru. This study is a qualitative descriptive research. TheÃ, total of 35Ã, data is in the form of sentences in data sources taken from the 2021 edition of the NHK Japan articles. The data collection method is the note-taking method. Data analysis uses theÃ, distributionalÃ, method with advanced techniques for direct elements, namely by dividing theÃ, fukugoudoushiÃ, forming elements into front and back elements. Furthermore, it explains the characteristics of the front elements based on the theory of Kindaichi (1989) which dividesÃ, doushiÃ, into 4 groups, namelyÃ, joutaidoushi,Ã, keizokudoushi,Ã, shunkandoushi, andÃ, daiyonshu-doushi. The results showed thatÃ, out ofÃ, 35 data analyzed there were front elements ofÃ, fukugoudoushiÃ, ~ageruÃ, in the form ofÃ, tadoushi-keizokudoushiÃ, (20 data),Ã, tadoushi-shunkandoushiÃ, (9 data),Ã, jidoushi-keizokudoushiÃ, (1Ã, datum),Ã, jidoushi-shunkandoushiÃ, (3 data), andÃ, futsuumeishiÃ, (2 data). The meanings resulting from the formation ofÃ, fukugoudoushi ~ageruÃ, include showing direction, showing improvement, showing high value, expressing self-demeaning, and ending an activity.
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
